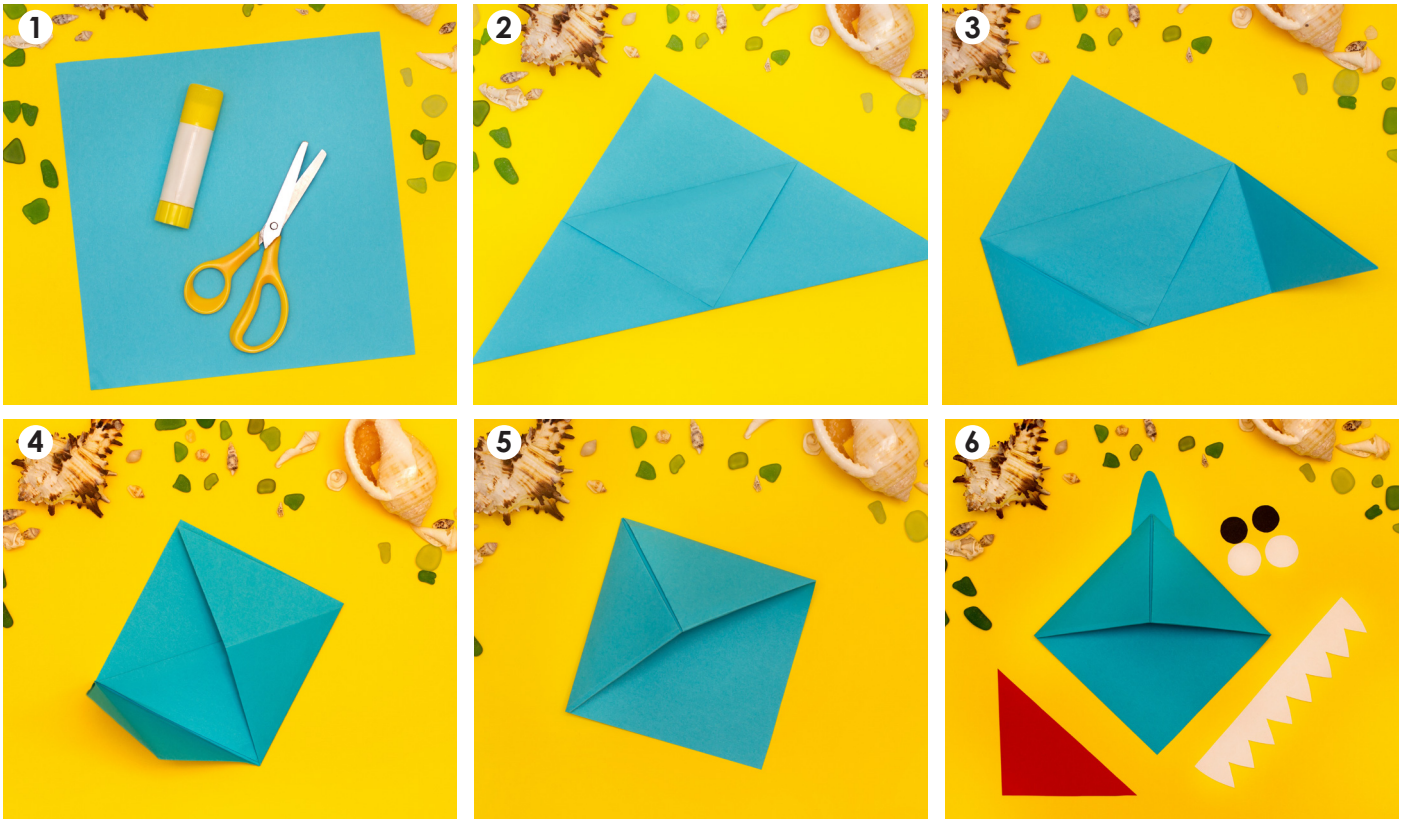


# Craft Project

Difficulty: **Intermediate**

**Note:** Some adult assistance required

## coverpaper | Baby Shark Bookmark



### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Prepare Your Materials:** Gather the blue cover paper, scissors, glue stick, and coloured paper for the shark's details (black, white, red).
- 2. Fold the Base:** Start with a square piece of blue cover paper. Fold the paper diagonally in half to form a triangle.
- 3. Fold the Corners:** Take the right corner of the triangle and fold it to the center point of the base. Repeat with the left corner, folding it to meet the center point as well.
- 4. Create the Pocket:** Unfold the corners, then fold the top layer of the bottom corner upwards, creating a pocket. Tuck the right and left corners into this pocket.
- 5. Finalize the Bookmark Shape:** You should now have a diamond shape with a pocket at the top. This is the base of your bookmark.
- 6. Add the Shark Details:** Cut out two small black circles and two slightly larger white circles for the eyes. Glue the black circles onto the white ones. Cut out a red triangle for the mouth and glue it to the inside of the pocket. Cut out small white triangles for the shark's teeth and glue them along the top edge of the red mouth. Finally, cut a small blue fin and glue it to the top of the bookmark.
