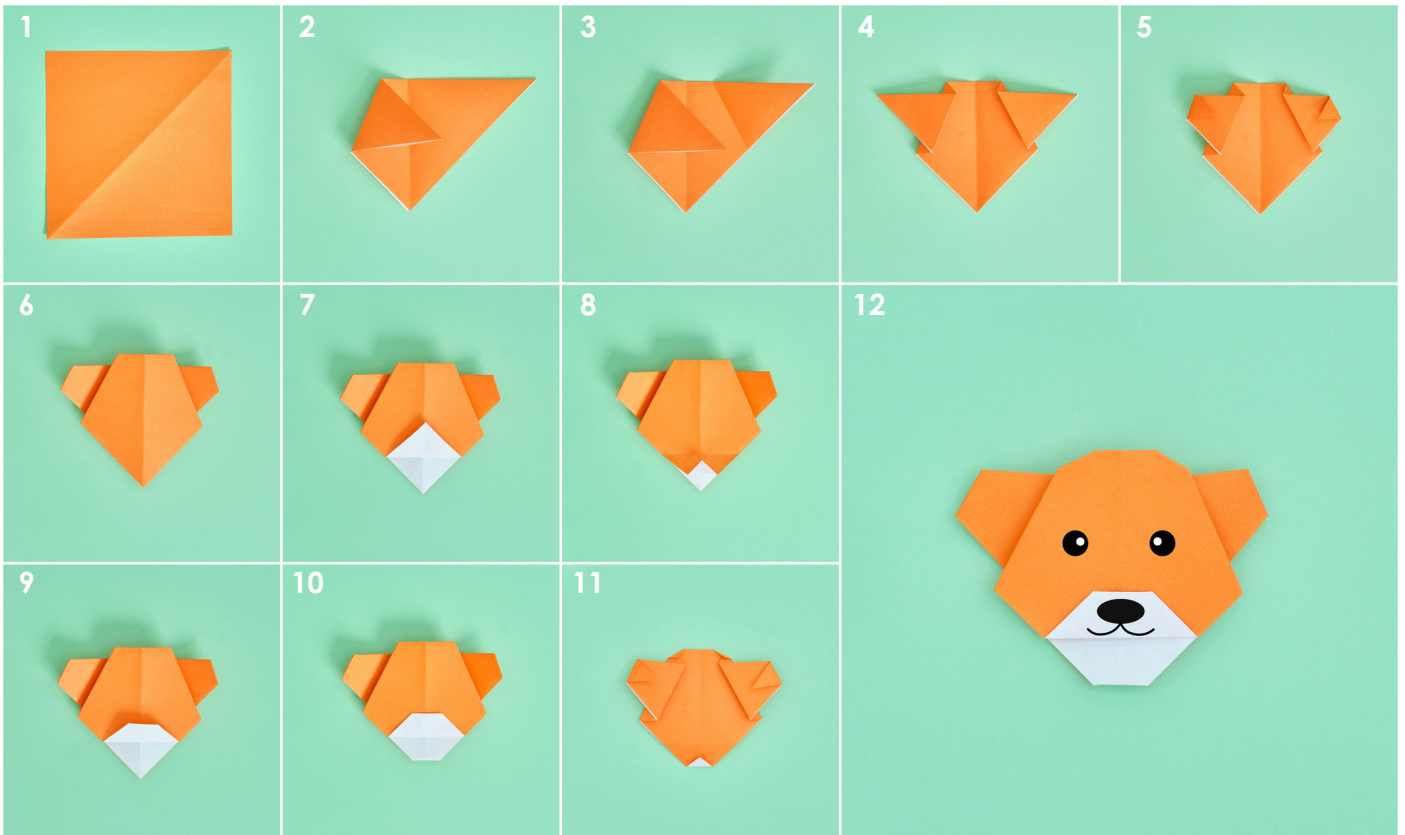


## kindershapes | Corgi Face



### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather your materials. Begin with an orange Glossy Paper Kinder Square and place it on a flat surface. Fold the square diagonally to form a triangle, aligning the corners.
2. To make the ears, take the left corner of the triangle and fold it inwards to meet the center line, creating a smaller triangle shape on the left side.
3. Take the right corner of the triangle and fold it inwards to meet the center line, creating a smaller triangle shape on the right side.
4. Now fold it away, follow the image example provided.
5. Fold the outermost parts of both ears inward to define their shape better.
6. Turn the origami piece over. You should see a triangle with two ear folds on either side.
7. Fold the bottom point of the triangle upwards slightly. This will reveal the white side of the paper, forming the Corgi's snout.
8. Fold the bottom section upwards again, using the previous fold as a guide.
9. Flip the origami over again and repeat the snout shaping by folding the bottom point upwards as in Step 7.

10. Fold the bottom section upwards once more, following the same technique from Step 8.
11. The back should resemble the shape shown in the corresponding image (Step 11). Now flip it back to the front.
12. Use a black marker to draw two eyes on the upper part of the Corgi's face, ensuring they are placed symmetrically.
