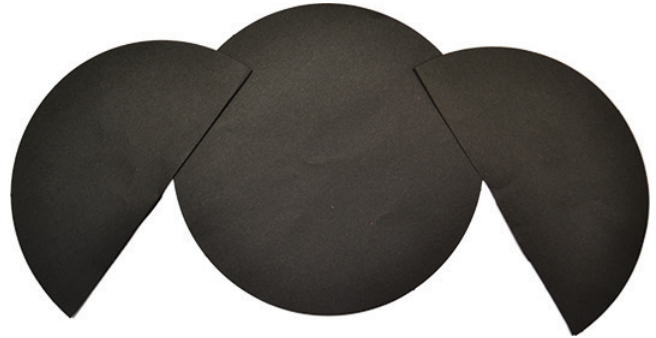

Scissors

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Get two black circles. One will be used for the body of the crow and the other to make the wings. Fold the circle for the wings in half and cut along fold line. Don't worry about being to precise as different cuts give each design a different look .
2. Glue you body to your backing paper/board. Then stick your wings over your body. Choose your wing position to show if your bird is flying or sitting. Have a bit of a play and see which one you like best.
3. Roughly cut out some legs, a beak and eyes. A yellow colour works best for the beak and legs. However you can choose any colours you like. Glue each section in place.
