

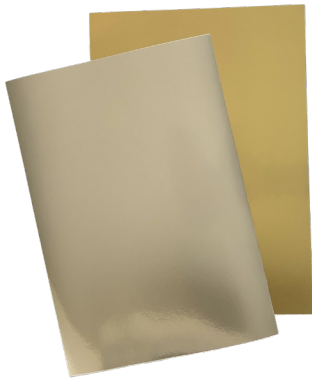

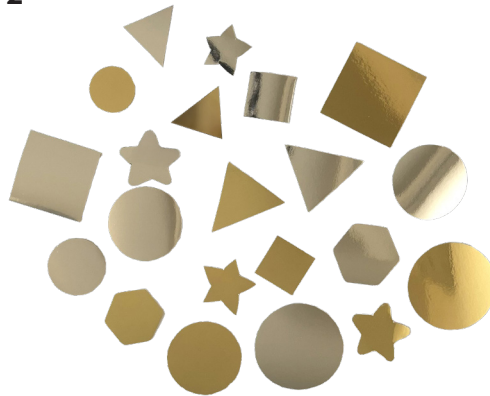

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Choose your foil board colours. Start with silver and gold foil boards, or mix it up with other colours from the FBA4 Assorted Pack. On the non-foil (back) side, sketch out different shapes in various sizes—like circles, squares, triangles, or stars.
2. Cut them out. Use scissors to carefully cut out all the shapes you've drawn.
3. Mix and match the shapes to build your own medal designs. Layer different shapes and use double-sided tape to stick them together.
4. Add the crepe paper ribbon. Choose your favourite crepe paper colour and cut it into strips about 1 inch wide. Unfold, then cut to your preferred length:
 - Use a longer strip if you want the medal to hang around your neck.
 - Use a shorter strip if you want to pin it to your chest. Tape the ribbon to the back of your medal to finish it off.
5. Get creative with colour. You can layer or combine different colours of crepe paper for extra flair.
6. Share the fun. Make a batch of medals and award them to your friends, classmates, or family members for fun or special occasions.
