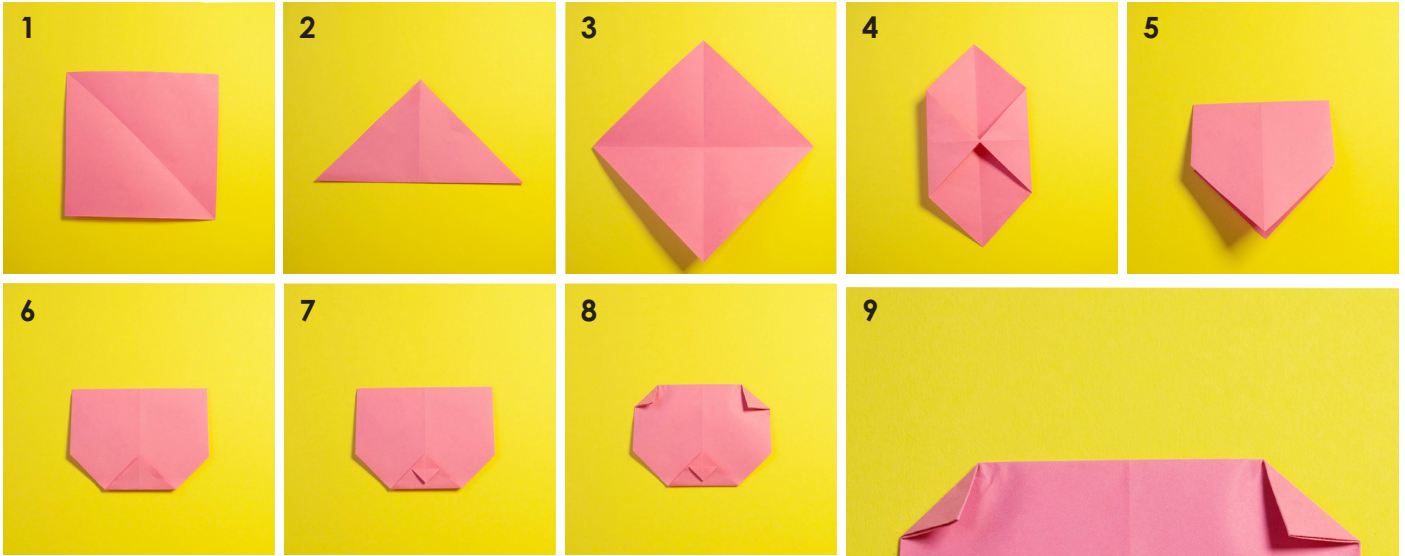
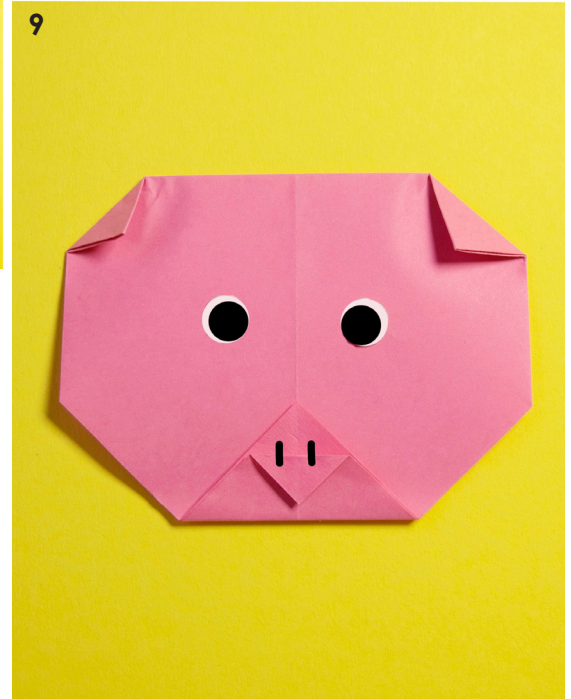


kindershapes | Pig



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Prepare Your Materials. Use a square piece of pink paper. Place it on a flat surface. Optionally, gather a black marker and googly eyes for decoration.
2. Fold Diagonally. Fold the square diagonally to form a triangle. Crease well, then unfold it to return to the square shape. This crease will guide future folds.
3. Fold the Other Diagonal. Fold along the opposite diagonal to create a second crease. Unfold again. The square should now have an "X" of diagonal creases.
4. Fold Side Edges to the Center. Bring the left and right corners of the square inward, aligning them along the center crease to form a diamond shape.
5. Create the Chin. Fold the bottom point of the diamond upward to create a flat edge, shaping the pig's chin.
6. Flatten the Bottom Edge. Fold the sharp corner at the bottom slightly upward to create a straight, flattened edge.
7. Adjust the Shape. Fold in the two side points on the bottom to soften the edges and form the base of the pig's face.
8. Create the Ears. Fold down the top two corners on each side to form the pig's ears. Angle the folds slightly for a more natural look.
9. Add Details. Use a black marker to draw the pig's nostrils on the chin area. Attach googly eyes with glue or draw them with your marker.
