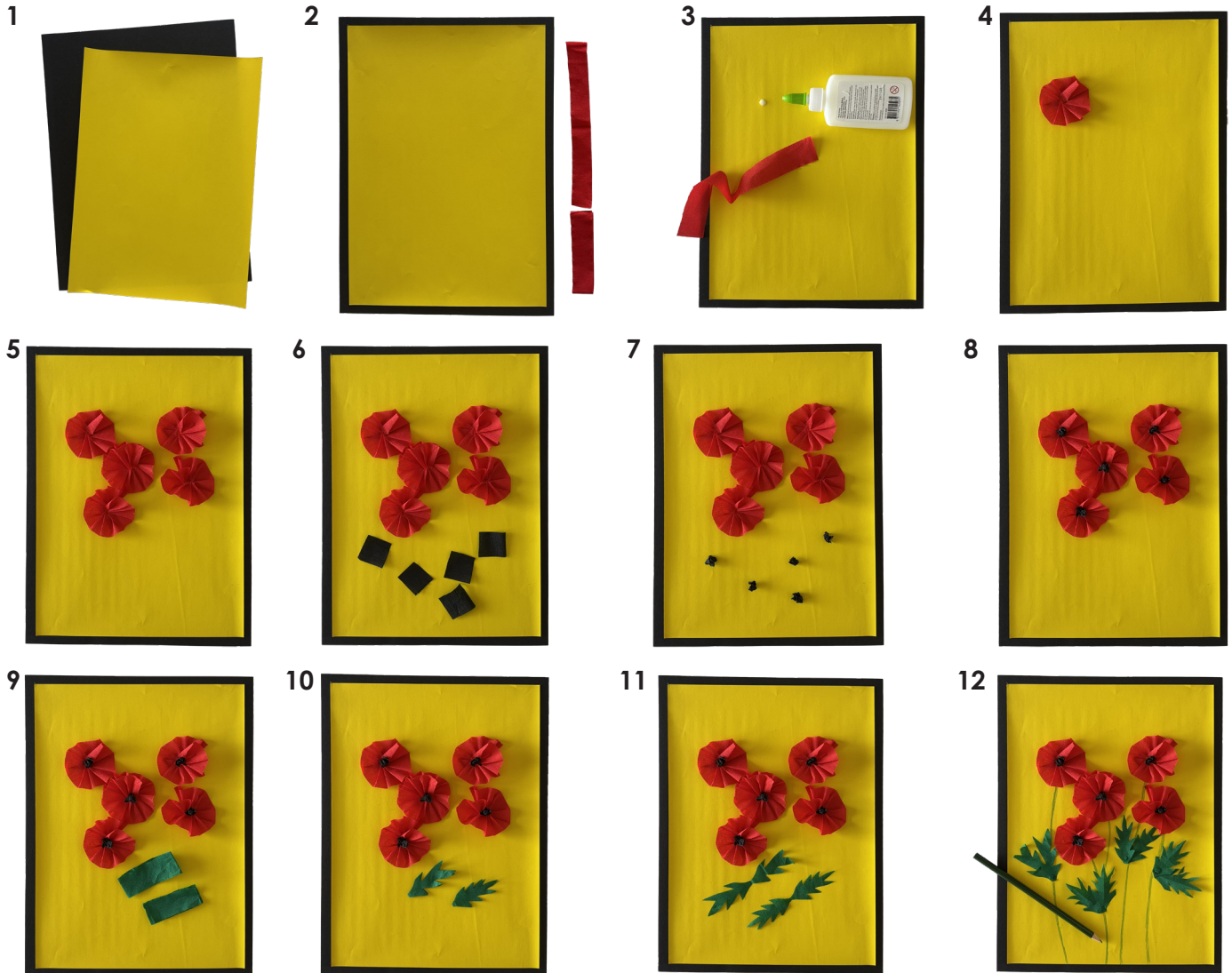


Craft Project

Difficulty: **Beginner**

Note: Some adult assistance required

schoolmountingpack | Poppies



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Select a coloured sheet to pair with a black poster board base.
2. Glue the school mounting packs together to form a framed background. Then, cut several strips of red crepe paper approximately 1 inch wide.
3. Add glue to the coloured sheet surface where you'd like to place your poppy flowers.
4. Place a red crepe paper strip over the glue. Using the lower edge of the strip, fold it in a circular motion to form a layered flower shape.
5. Repeat to make more flowers. Create at least five poppy flowers, or more if desired.
6. Prepare the flower centres. Cut black crepe paper into small 1-inch squares.
7. Roll each black square into a small ball.

8. Glue a black crepe paper ball to the centre of each red flower.
9. Cut a strip of green crepe paper about 5–6 inches long and fold it in half.
10. Cut out leaf shapes from the folded green crepe paper, making sure not to cut along the folded edge.
11. Unfold the leaves and gently fold them into a "V" shape to create dimension. Glue them onto the poster board around each flower.
12. Use a green coloured pencil or crayon to draw stems from the flowers down to the base of the board.
