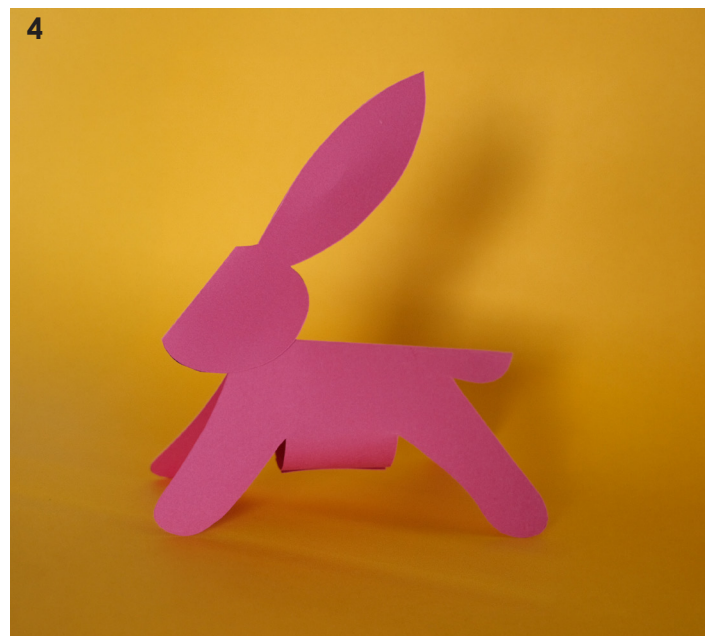
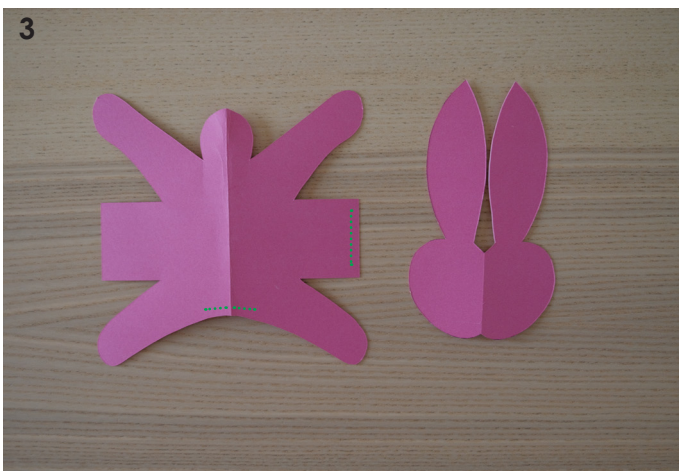
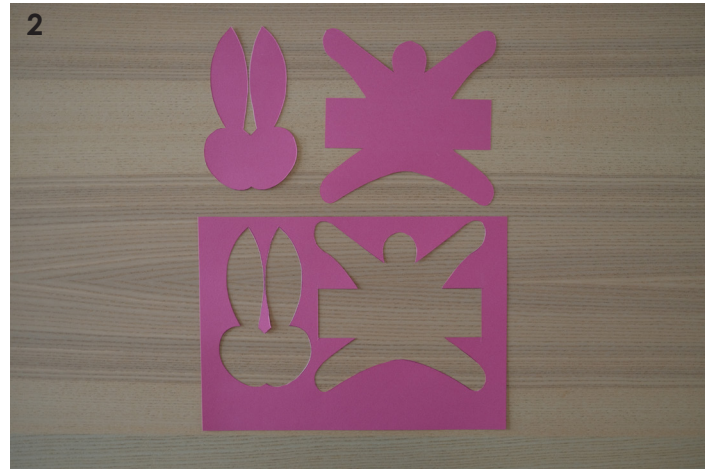


Craft Project

spectrumboard | Rabbit



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print the provided rabbit template from www.austpaper.com.au/craft. Use spectrum board for durability. Have scissors and glue or double-sided tape ready.
2. Cut Out the Pieces: Carefully cut out all the parts from the template, as shown in image #2. Ensure smooth edges for a clean finish.
3. Fold the Body and Head: Gently fold along the marked creases on the rabbit's body and head to create a 3D shape, as shown in image #3. Apply glue or double-sided tape on the green lines indicated in the example (image #3).
4. Assemble the Rabbit: Attach the head to the body, aligning it properly for a seamless look. Press the glued sections firmly to ensure everything is secure. Your 3D rabbit is complete! Display it proudly or use it as part of a decorative setup.
