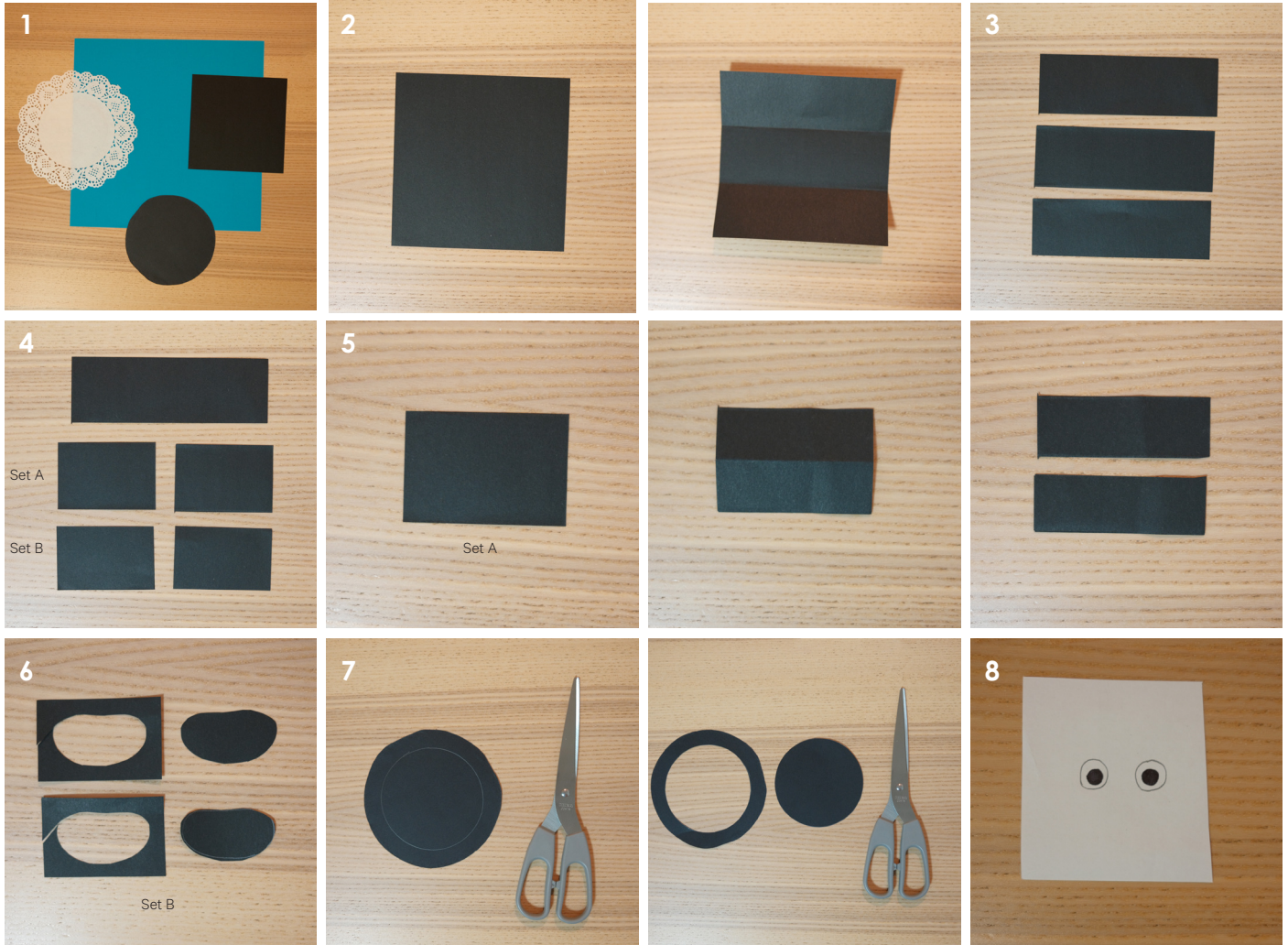


doyleys | Sheep



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather your materials. Collect all the materials needed for this project.
2. Prepare the Black Paper. Start with the matt kinder square paper and use the black paper.
3. Create Sections. Fold the black paper into thirds and cut it into three equal sections.
4. Prepare Legs and Ears. Fold two of the sections in half and cut them to create two pieces. Label these as Set A (for the legs) and Set B (for the ears).
5. For Set A, take one piece, fold it in half, and cut along the fold to create two leg pieces.

6. For Set B, draw a bean shape on the remaining piece of black paper to make the sheep's ears and cut them out.
7. For the circle that will be the sheep's head, trim it slightly to ensure it fits nicely on the doyley.
8. Draw a set of eyes on a piece of white paper and cut them out.
9. Assemble the sheep. Start by gluing the two legs on the blue sheet of matt paper. Next, attach the doyley to form the body of the sheep. Then, paste the trimmed circle as the sheep's head. Finally, glue the two ears and the eyes onto the head to complete your sheep.
